<p>Force to organise briefing sessions for schools' Designated Safeguarding Leads (DSL) in every school in the force area. (Operation Encompass will provide PowerPoint briefings if requested). These briefings will ensure that the confidential, sensitive and dynamic information which is held by the police will be treated appropriately by the schools.</p> <p>Comment:</p>	
<p>Force to hold contact details for all trained DSLs in Operation Encompass</p>	
<p>Police will ensure that all frontline officers understand Operation Encompass and the importance of sharing information with schools to support children exposed to DA.</p> <p>Comment:</p>	
<p>Police provide schools with a joint force and schools letter informing parents about school's participation in Operation Encompass.</p> <p>Comment:</p>	
<p>The police will record and collate numbers of children supported and share these figures with the Operation Encompass charity.</p> <p>Comment:</p>
